APPENDIX 2

Project information

Proposed Activity: A request for an ORET grant has been made by a Dutch dredging contractors company (Hollandsche Aannemers Maatschappij) for an export transaction involving an urban improvement project in the Central and South Guasmo area of the city of Guayaquil, Ecuador.

The project consists of dredging sediment from a borrow area in the river Guayas with a trailing suction hopper dredger, transporting the sand, and hydraulic filling of areas to be reclaimed. During the operation, the houses that are present in the areas to be reclaimed, can remain in place. In addition, the project comprises the design of a Masterplan for the fill area and design and implementation of a basic drainage system. Main objective of the proposed project is improving the living conditions.

The review advice concerns the EIS and its complement.
