Dear Minister,

By e-mail dated 10 January 2007 and communications following that mail, you requested the Netherlands Commission for Environmental Assessment (hereafter 'the Commission') to advise on harvesting the methane resource and monitoring the stratification of Lake Kivu. It is my pleasure to submit herewith the advice prepared by a working group of the Commission.
